The Admiralty has at last agreed that I may start experiments, and I can give you £25 a month for three months. Would you like to start work on Monday, April 8th? Meanwhile you might look up a good quantitative test of manual skill, e.g. time taken to do some more or less skilled operation. We will have a similar arithmetical one. I cannot promise you anything for more than three months, but if you get your foot on the ladder, you may be able to get up a bit.
