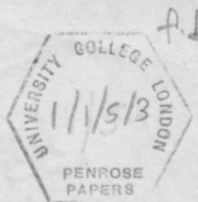

I should think that a glance through the Digest of burials of Norfolk and Norwich quarterly meeting would reveal the necessary information. It might take some time, as the entries are arranged under each letter of the alphabet in rough chronological order.

E. Josephine Penrose, in 1923, sent a list to the Library of Friends in the burial ground; it is only of those who had gravestones and does not begin until 1781.

Under Peckover, in the Burial digest, I notice that the first entry is for a James, who was buried at Fakenham in 1689.

Would you be able to come to look through the registers yourself? - or would you prefer that a member of the Library staff did so?
