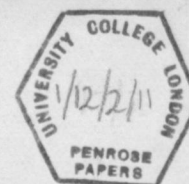

I have discussed with The Trust your idea that the £150. per annum rent of the Studios received by you from Mr. Hoyland should be paid to The Trust who would make a contribution of the same amount towards the upkeep of the Thorington Hall garden.

As things stand at present you are the legal owner of the Studios. Unless you release your life interest in these buildings to The Trust the Trust cannot lease them to Mr. Hoyland. Even then The Trust would be most reluctant to enter into an arrangement which would really be a device for reducing the amount of Income Tax paid by you.
